

Rhodesian Ridgeback Dog Breed's Personality Traits – Guide

If you want to relish the pleasure of being accompanied by your Emotional Support Dog, you must get an [emotional support animal letter](#) from a permitted and certified practitioner. This special letter is an official document that includes the recommendation for taking your ESA along with you anywhere you go or stay. There is no average life expectancy defined for dogs generally, however, they may live from 10 to 13 years. Generally, it has been reported that smaller dogs enjoy a longer lifespan as compared to larger ones. Possibly a better method to calculate a dog's long life is via conversion of years of dog's life into human years.

The Rhodesian Ridgeback is a complete package in itself as it could be referred to as a Renaissance hound whose characteristic is the ridge of regressively grown hair, on his backbone. In native African countries, this breed has been well-known for its characteristic skills of tracking, however, they have never killed lions or other animals. Nowadays, Ridgebacks are being admired and cherished family dogs whose possessors need to be well-prepared all the time for dealing with the independent and strong prey drive of these privileged dogs.

The Rhodesian Ridgeback characterizes a robust, muscular, and active dog that is symmetrical as well as extremely balanced in outlook. Generally, grown-up dogs of breed Ridgeback are found to be attractive, upstanding, athletic, and handsome hounds who are competent and able of great stamina with a good amount of speed. They are gregarious, loving, and protective. They also

could be referred to as natural watchdogs as they are protective towards family members including care for small children. There is a Separate [ESA letter for housing](#) for ESA to be kept at home.

One of the special traits of Rhodesian Ridgeback dogs is their devotion towards their owner, even if the owner has a fairly dignified temperament, these Ridgeback dogs would be affectionate towards their possessor or master while being extremely reserved with outsiders. The uniqueness of this breed's dog is having a ridge or stripe on the backbone. This ridge feature must be considered as the distinctive breed trait.

Elevated desire or drive to prey and staying aloof with outsiders or strangers are not certainly the best traits of the Rhodesian Ridgeback breed. This is so because the higher drive to prey could consequently result in your Rhodesian Ridgeback hunting, chasing, or hurting other beings and animals along with other pets in the home, and being staying aloof or reserved with others may result in fearful aggression that is not desirable at all. You will need an [emotional support dog letter](#) for your dog.

Other characteristic personality traits of Ridgeback hounds include their intelligence, loyalty, protectiveness, higher drive to prey, independence, and stubbornness. These traits are highly appreciable and desirable, however, sometimes handling these Ridgeback breed dogs become extremely challenging for the owner as their aggressiveness or hunting desire may lead to an undesirable consequence.
